



Attached please find the 2019-20 Parent Immunization Letter giving you information on the required immunizations for each school aged child.

According to Colorado law, any child with vaccinations not up to date, in process, or with an appropriate exemption on file will be unable to attend school on the first day.

House Bill 1312 would create a standardized exemption form that every parent opting their kids out of vaccinations for personal or religious reasons would have to fill out in person at the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment. They could renew the request online going forward. It also gives the Board of Health authority to decide what immunizations kids need to attend school using criteria from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.

This bill has currently passed the house committee and we will keep any parents who wish to exempt their child from vaccinations up to date on this important legislation.

Please be sure to get your child up to date on his or her vaccinations this summer. The Clear Creek County Public Health department in Idaho Springs takes walk ins for immunizations. For more information call Crystal Brandt, RN at 303-670-7545.

Also, if your child has any medications at his or her school, please be sure to pick them up before the last day. Any medications left will be disposed of on May 24th. Also, be advised that any medical forms needed for next year are located on the School Nurse website for Clear Creek School District (<https://sites.google.com/a/ccsdre1.org/nurse/>).
