The School-based Therapy Program is an innovative collaboration between Jefferson Center and Clear Creek Public Schools with the primary goal of increasing access to mental health services for students and their families. The program provides a counselor onsite at Carlson elementary and Clear Creek middle and high schools. We are pleased to let you know that Sue Crawford is the School-based counselor at Carlson Elementary School.

Sue is a Licensed Professional Counselor, who may offer support or crisis intervention to students as needed and will ask for a parent's consent before providing more ongoing support. She is also available to help students and their families through individual, family and group counseling. She may also visit some classrooms to teach topics on good mental health, social skills, conflict mediation and expressing feelings

In order to provide this service free to students, we collect the name, Medicaid number (if applicable) and birthday of students who receive services to verify children served for our funding sources.
